

April 2, 2021: Construction Update No. 22 Bridge Avenue Reconstruction Project

The Bridge Avenue Reconstruction Project resumed on March 29, 2021. Bridge Avenue will be closed from the southerly Fairground entrance (north of Minnie Maddern) to Hammer Road. Ulland Brothers, Inc. will be the prime contractor on this project. Freeborn County and the City of Albert Lea collaborated on this project and have hired SRF Consulting Group to provide construction oversight.

Construction activity completed this week:

- Bridge Avenue closed from Minnie Maddern to Hammer Road.
- Detour route set up.
- Pavement removed from Minnie Maddern to Richway Drive.

Construction activity for next week will be the following:

- Remove and replace fence along Fairgrounds.
- Begin installation of storm sewer and watermain from Minnie Maddern to Richway Drive.

Safety is always our highest concern during construction of these types of projects:

- Please slow down through construction zone for the safety of others, and the workers on site, as well as your own safety. Avoid using a cellular phone when walking or driving near a construction zone.
- Please stay clear of machinery and construction trenches in the work zone. Construction vehicles can move quickly and suddenly. Staying alert to your surroundings reduces the likelihood of an incident.
- In addition, your assistance in directing your children away from construction areas is appreciated.
