

October 15, 2021: Construction Update No. 46 Bridge Avenue Reconstruction Project

The Bridge Avenue Reconstruction Project is nearing completion for 2021. **On Tuesday, September 7, Ulland Brothers closed the Hammer Road Intersection for seven weeks.** Please follow the signed detour that will be provided. This is the final stretch of road to be constructed. Once it is completed, Bridge Avenue will be paved and opened once again, with the final lift of bituminous paving to occur in 2022.

Construction activity completed this week:

- Roadway grading at Troy.
- Completed installing storm sewer at Hammer intersection.

Construction activity for next week will be the following:

- Begin work on Hammer traffic signal.
- Install sod and concrete curb between Richway and Glenview.
- Roadway grading between Troy and Hammer.

Safety is always our highest concern during construction of these types of projects:

- Please slow down through construction zone for the safety of others, and the workers on site, as well as your own safety. Avoid using a cellular phone when walking or driving near a construction zone.
- Please stay clear of machinery and construction trenches in the work zone. Construction vehicles can move quickly and suddenly. Staying alert to your surroundings reduces the likelihood of an incident.
- In addition, your assistance in directing your children away from construction areas is appreciated.
